VOTE NO ON THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR RECALL

CNA is urging all California nurses to vote No on recalling Gov. Gavin Newsom.

Nurses have endured far too much from the current pandemic. But we also know the toll would have been far worse without the safety measures that have been employed.

With the current, more transmissible Delta surge and cases rising, this is not the time to throw out public health and safety protections. Yet that is what will happen if the recall passes.

All the leading recall candidates want to roll back public health measures that protect the lives and health of millions of Californians, including nurses, our co-workers, and our families. That would certainly include all workplace safety protections opposed by the California hospital industry from safe staffing to workplace violence prevention.
